

2013 FORT MCCOY QUOTA HUNTING INFORMATION AND APPLICATION

The application and selection process for all fall quota hunt permits (Gun-Deer, Cantonment Archery, and Fall Turkey) was revised in 2012 to meet Department of the Army regulations. Permit selection is no longer done on a first-come-first-serve basis. Selection will be based on a random drawing of all applications within each Category (A, B or C) with separate permit allotments established for each category (see Category definition on application information sheet).

- Category allotments are: (A) 25%, (B) 15%, and (C) 60%.

* Some Category A and B applicants were not selected because they applied as a group with a Category C applicant(s) who were not selected.

** The total number of permits selected represents Youth Mentorship participants, which do not count against the quota, and military personnel stationed at Fort McCoy after the permit quota was met.

- Category A applicants will be drawn first followed by Category B and then Category C. Any Category A or B allotments not filled during the selection process will be available for the Category C drawing.
- Applications must be received or postmarked by the deadline date (**June 14, 2013**).
- Applications can be mailed or dropped off at the Permit Sales Office.
- Group applications will still be accepted. Further information is listed in the application instructions.

2013 hunting season changes: Several changes are being implemented for the 2013 hunting seasons. These changes were discussed in early 2012 and are being developed to maintain a safe and enjoyable hunting experience. These changes will be outlined in the 2013 hunting regulations. Specific procedures will be provided to all quota hunt recipients as well as posted on the Fort McCoy Public Website, Hunter Information Point, and Permit Sales Office.

- **Hunter Ethics and Safety:** There has been increased reporting of unethical and unsafe hunting practices. Additional guidance and penalties will be defined in the regulations in 2013.
- **Automated Sign-in and Information System:** A system is being developed to enhance communication and allow for hunter sign-in. The system will allow hunters to sign-in/sign-out using their computer, smartphone, telephone (cell phone and landline), or on-site kiosk. Specific procedures will be provided to all quota hunt recipient as well as posted on the Fort McCoy Public Website, Hunter Information Point, and Permit Sales Office.
- **Hunter Sign-in Requirements:** All hunters (including Gun-Deer, Cantonment Archery, Regular Archery, Small Game, and Spring and Fall Turkey) will be required to sign-in and sign-out of Fort McCoy.
- **Gun-Deer Hunting Zones:** Specific hunting zones are being developed for the Gun-Deer season. We anticipate having 6 zones (3 on North Post and 3 on South Post). Gun-Deer hunters will be required to sign-in to 1 of 6 hunting zones while hunting. Hunters will need to be familiar with the training areas within each zone and follow the training area closure listed on the Game Line.

The Muzzle-Loader Season has been discontinued.

The Youth Mentorship Program: Fort McCoy does not have a specific Youth Hunt; however youth (10 and 11 years old) can participate in any Fort McCoy hunt. All participants (youth and mentors) must follow Fort McCoy regulations, WDNR guidelines and rules associated with the program, and obtain the proper Fort McCoy permit(s).

Concealed Weapons: Wisconsin law allowing individuals to carry a concealed weapon with the proper permit does not apply to Fort McCoy. **In accordance with Army Regulation 190-11 para 4-5, possession of a concealed weapon is prohibited on Fort McCoy. Carrying a concealed weapon will result in criminal prosecution, fines, revocation or suspension of hunting, fishing, trapping and firewood cutting privileges, and/or other disciplinary actions.**

Deer Hunt for Persons with Disabilities: Fort McCoy will hold a 2-day deer hunt for persons with disabilities on **October 5 and 6, 2013**. This hunt is open to those with a Wisconsin Category A, B, C, or D disability. Individuals with a Wisconsin Category B disability **AND** authorization to hunt from a vehicle are eligible to apply for this hunt. **This hunt requires a separate application. Applications will be available June 1, 2013 and will need to be received by September 9, 2013. Contact the Permit Sales Office for specific information and application.**

2013 QUOTA HUNT APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Application Deadline is June 14, 2013.

Applications may be mailed or hand-delivered to the Permit Sales Office. Hand-delivered applications **must be received by 3:30 p.m. on June 14, 2013 to be eligible for the drawing.** Applications postmarked after June 14, 2013 will be returned.

- **DNR CUSTOMER NUMBER:** ALL applicants must provide a DNR Customer Number. Individuals who do not yet have a DNR Customer Number will need to obtain one before applying for a Fort McCoy permit. Contact a WDNR Service Center or call their toll free number at 1-888-936-7463 (7 days a week from 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.) to have one created. **Applications without the DNR Customer Number will be returned.**
- **SELECTION PROCESS AND CATEGORIES:** **ALL** applicants are required to identify their status (Category A, B, C). Military personnel, Fort McCoy civilians, and the general public **all** must apply during the application period to have an opportunity to obtain a permit. Any applications without a category selected or without proper category verification (see below) will be entered into the Category C drawing.
 - **Category A:** Active and Retired Military, Reserves and National Guard and military dependent ID card holders. **A photocopy of current Military ID is required with all Category A applications.** Applicants that provided proof of Category in 2012 must still provide the information with their 2013 application. **Any social security number displayed on the copy of your ID must be BLOCKED OUT.**
 - **Category B:** Department of Defense (DoD) and Non-Appropriated Fund (NAF) civilians, retired government civilians, other US Government Civilian ID Card Holders, and legal dependents (spouses and children 18 years old and younger). **A photocopy of Civilian/Retired Civilian government employee ID is required with application.** Applicants that provided proof of Category in 2012 must provide the information with their 2013 application. Retired government civilian employees may supply a copy of their retirement SF50 or a retired civilian ID card. **Legal dependents must fill out the affidavit on the application and provide copy of parent/guardian government employee ID. Any social security number displayed on the copy of your ID must be BLOCKED OUT.** The Fort McCoy Personnel Services Branch can issue ID cards for retired civilian personnel. ID cards are issued in Building 35 from 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Monday through Friday. Please call (608) 388-4563 prior to visiting.
 - **Category C:** General Public (those who do not qualify for Category A or B). No copy of ID required.
- **GROUP APPLICATIONS:** **A maximum of 4 applications may be sent per envelope.** All applications submitted in one envelope as a group must be the same category (A, B, or C). **Any groups with multiple categories will be included in the drawing at the lowest category (i.e., a group with Category A and C applications will be included in the Category C drawing).** Youth (10 and 11 years) applications can be mailed along with, and in addition to, any group application and does not count towards the maximum of 4 applications per envelope. Each applicant, including youth, must submit a separate application with **their** correct mailing address. **Each applicant within a group will be mailed notification of selection(s). Successful applicants will receive notification of their selection(s) and instructions on how to purchase their permit from an authorized WDNR ALIS agent.**
- **PERMIT COST and PAYMENT:** **PAYMENT IS NOT REQUIRED AT TIME OF APPLICATION.** Successful applicants will receive notification from the Permit Sales Office to purchase their permit from an authorized WDNR ALIS agent. **Permits are non-refundable/non-transferable.**
- **2013 QUOTA HUNT SELECTIONS:**
 - GUN-DEER SEASON:** The Fort McCoy Gun-Deer season coincides with the State of Wisconsin Deer Gun season (November 23 - December 1, 2013).
 - HUNTER'S CHOICE APPROVAL CHECKBOX:** The 2013 Fall Hunting application has a Hunter's Choice Approval (HCA) check box under the Gun-Deer section. Individuals who mark this box will have their name entered into a **drawing** for a Hunter's Choice Approval. Individuals with a Fort McCoy Hunters Choice Approval can harvest one deer of either sex at anytime during the Fort McCoy Gun-Deer season using their WDNR Gun Buck Deer Carcass tag. Hunters 18 years old and younger will automatically receive a HCA. **The HCA is not a bonus deer tag.**

FALL TURKEY SEASON: If you are selected for a Fort McCoy Fall Turkey Permit you are not allowed to apply for a State of Wisconsin Fall Turkey Permit, however you can purchase any left-over Wisconsin turkey permit over-the-counter; if available (contact the WDNR for more information). If you are selected for a Fort McCoy Fall Turkey Permit, you will be notified prior to the Wisconsin Fall Turkey Permit Application deadline (August 1, 2013). **Applicants that apply for a State of Wisconsin Fall Turkey Permit and are not drawn may apply for a Fort McCoy Fall Turkey Permit.**

CANTONMENT ARCHERY: The Fort McCoy Cantonment Archery season begins September 14, 2013. Further details will be outlined in the 2013 Cantonment Archery hunting regulations.

- **APPLICATION ENVELOPES:** Applications must be received in an application envelope. Hand-delivered applications should also be in an envelope, especially if applying as a group. An example of the information required on your application envelope is provided below.

- **SUCCESSFUL APPLICANTS:** Successful applicants will be mailed a notification letter indication which quota hunt they are authorized to hunt and instruction on how to purchase their permit. All applicants selected for Fort McCoy quota hunts will be notified by mail and must purchase/possess the appropriate Wisconsin hunting license (e.g. 2013 Gun-Deer, Archery, Senior Citizen Recreation Card or Conservation Patron License, and Turkey Stamp if required by the state). **Unsuccessful applicants will receive notification of the selection results.**
- **APPLICATION PROCESSING:** Successful applicants for a Fall quota hunting season(s) should receive notification in the mail by **August 9, 2013**. **These dates are approximate.** Applications will be processed as quickly as possible. Please do not call to see if you were selected for a permit before August 12, 2013.

If ID or signed affidavit for Category B is not supplied, applications will be entered into the Category C drawing. **Social Security number (SSN) on any photocopied ID MUST be BLACKED OUT.**

Category A: Active and Retired Military, Reserves and National Guard and Military Dependent ID Card holders. A photocopy of Military, Retired Military, or Military Dependent ID is required **(Black Out any SSN).**
